22-25 April 2024, Rotterdam, The Netherlands

KEY TAKEAWAYS

- 1 Managing successful global energy transitions is essential, not straightforward, and cannot be achieved by one nation or network alone. The historic processes that established contemporary energy systems will not be able to progress us forward at the pace and scale required for net-zero and beyond.
- 2 New forms of radical collaboration are emerging, and an increasing recognition that more people and diverse communities need to better understand their roles and choices as the world prepares for a more demanding energy future. Humanising Energy is our call to action. Energy leadership can and must do a better job with global energy literacy.
- 3 Everyone is faced with the same journey and destination, but the starting points and methods for advancing clean and inclusive energy transitions differ extensively. In many parts of the world, decisions about the shape of energy transitions do not come from a position of comfort and convenience with access to modern energy. In most of Africa, for example, energy is an existential issue – and the pathways towards decarbonisation and climate resilient energy systems are accompanied by a call for justice.
- 4 Our capacity and ability to respond to the unprecedented challenges that face us require agility and a willingness to adapt and evolve. The practical World Energy Trilemma Framework is being retooled to connect the dots between energy security, equity and sustainability to better respond to the contemporary demands of energy systems.
- 5 There is a shared responsibility to engage with everyone – leaders, consumers, producers, storers, co-creators, and designers of energy - and rise up to the challenge to shape the next century of world energy for people and planet.



“A heartfelt thank you to all who joined the 26th World Energy Congress to get on with the urgent task of redesigning energy for people and planet. What emerged is that there are many opportunities to redesign energy for billions of better lives and a healthy planet, and these differ by region.






